WHAT IS A DIRECTIVE?

You can think of a directive like a mini-resolution. Directives are sent on notes to the dais, and sometimes the dais can receive over 200 directives at one conference! Delegates can write and send directives individually, or in groups.

WHY DO YOU SUBMIT DIRECTIVES?

You submit a directive whenever you want to make an action that affects the crisis' situation---this is something you cannot do in debate. For example, you can't say "I am storming Russia!", you need to submit a directive to make that action happen.

PUBLIC

Voted on by whole committee

Requires 1/2 majority

Affects the whole committee

Requires 2 sponsors and 5 signatories
